

Visa Inc. makes political contributions in strict compliance with applicable laws and the Visa Inc. Political Participation, Lobbying, and Contributions Policy. While corporations are not permitted to contribute to U.S. federal political campaigns or to national political parties, they can contribute to state and local candidates in many jurisdictions and 527 organizations. Political contributions will not be given in anticipation of, in recognition of, or in return for, any official act and corporate funds may not be used for any unlawful, improper, or unethical purpose. The following is a list of political contributions Visa made in the U.S. and abroad during calendar year 2019.

This report includes payments to other tax exempt organizations engaged in advocacy (including 501(c)(3), (4), and (6) organizations) if it was determined that the contribution in question was used for political purposes. The political contributions listed are aggregated on a yearly basis and may reflect contributions to multiple campaign committees associated with a single legislator, and also may reflect primary and/or general election contributions and party conferences. All contributions are listed in U.S. dollars. All contributions disclosed in this report were initiated in calendar year 2019, but the report does not reflect whether the payments have been processed by the recipient.

In addition, the report includes a section disclosing the names of the Company's membership in any U.S. trade association whose annual membership dues was \$25,000 or higher, regardless of whether any portion of those dues were used for political purposes.
